FIELD VISIT- KE SAFIYA AUTISM CENTRE



The Department of Psychology had organized a field trip for the 2nd year and 3rd year students of CPA College of Global Studies to KE Safiya Autism Centre, Mahe, Kannur on 16th November 2022 in regarding to World mental health day - 10th October and International day of persons with disabilities - 3rd December. This field visit was organized under the guidance of our HOD Mrs Dhanya mam and was attended by 37 students. The students were accompanied by Mrs Dhanya, Linitha and Mr Noorudheen (faculties of CPA College of Global Studies). This school is dedicated for the service to autistic children belonging to various age groups. The students reached the destination by 10:30 am. As soon as we entered the institution we were guided to the hall where all the Autistic, Intellectual disabled, Down's syndrome, Cerebral Palsy etc. students were seated. The Principal of the institution Mrs Shashikala began the session by presenting us with a documentary that includes every milestone and condition of a child life through autistic way. Small games were conducted for the children for which they were awarded. At the end, all the children were presented with a small gift. The session ended with few cultural programs by the children. Later, the children were taken back to their respective classes and the students were shown around the school that is the special labs required for them. The teaching procedure in this special school entails separately designed and methodically scrutinized compilation of coaching assessments, custom-made tools and equipments, along with the accessible settings. These intrusions are intended to aid students having special needs of attaining an advanced level of individual self-reliance and achievement in school, college, and their society. These children need a lot of attention and care for which there should be good facilities and faculties to handle. This field of work needs to be reorganized and supported on a large scale. The students gained knowledge about it and hope to contribute to it in the future. By noon, the students set back home. On the way back, the students got a chance to visit the Sargaalaya arts and crafts Village, Vatakara.
