Inauguration Of NSS Unit






Update 2021-Graduate Development Programme

On 12th January 2021, the second day of the Webinar series, the resource person was Dr. THOIBA KOTTEKKATTU, Scientific officer, forensic science laboratory, DCB, Malappuram, Kerala. The topic of the lecture was the Role of Forensic Biology in Crime Scene Investigation. She explained about crime scene sample collection, analysis, live and mobile forensic events and the forensic science laboratories in India. She explained the categories of biological evidences in crime scene, forensic entomology and forensic odontology. She explained about the botanical evidences in crime scene and forensic Botany.

For the 3rd day of the Webinar series, our resource person was Dr. VIVEK P. J. Assistan t Professor, Department of Botany, SNGS College Pattambi. The topic was Bioinformatics Application in Life Science and Technologies.
