STUDY TRIP TO ICAR- CPCRI, Kasaragod

The Post Graduate Department of Botany of CPA college of Global Studies conducted a one day study trip to "ICAR-CPCRI, Kasaragod" on 14 March, 2022. They were a group of thirty three members.

CPCRI Headquarters is located 5 kilometres away from Kasaragod town and 51 Kilometres from Manglore on the Manglore –Kasaragod road. The team met Dr. Aparna Veluru, who was their programme co-ordinator. The welcome session was inaugurated by Dr. K. Samsudheen (Senior Scientist) at Diamond jubilee hall. Field Visit

The group visited Coconut plantations and nurseries. There were well maintained nurseries, store room, pre - germination bed, pre-nursery and main nursery. Sudha Madam explained about mother palm selection, quality seedling production, hybridisation techniques in Coconut etc. After that Dr. Panchavarnam joined and the team visited multicropping system, where Pepper, Banana , Pineapple,Nutmeg, Cocoa, Arecanut, Cinnamon were planted along with coconut. She discussed about high density multicropping system and intercropping system. Students and teachers also visited beach plot, where intercropping system between Coconut and Sappota was done. Later the team visited pollen processing unit, where they were able to see male flower processing done by Sibin. He gave a brief idea on pollen processing and storage.

Lab visit

The demonstration of climbing machine was done by Krishnaveni, field worker. After that the team visited tissue culture lab, molecular biology lab, pathology lab, Entomology lab and at last they visited Nematology lab. They got familiarised with many equipments, pests, diseases, control measures etc.

Tholpetty Wildlife Sanctuary is a place exclusively for wildlife enthusiasts and nature lovers who would like a bit of adventure. Although limited, the Jeep Safari is a great opportunity to enjoy the dense forests and stunning scenery all around. Herds of elephants, sambar deer, wild buffalo, bears, Malabar antelopes, occasional tigers and panthers were seen frequently. The lake that passes through the sanctuary is another interesting place to see the wild animals as they come there in search of water. The team spent three beautiful days in and out of the jungle. As they walked through the jungle for 16 kilometres they came across a variety of wildlife.
