We Are All Born Equal

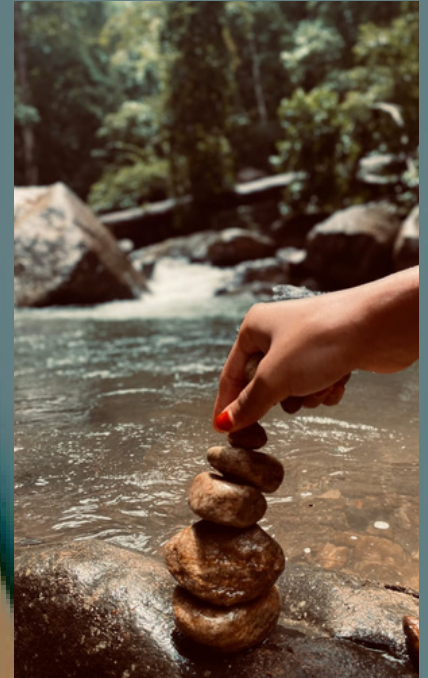

A three day nature study camp was organized for the 2nd year students of department BTTM at Chinnar Wildlife Sanctuary as a part of UPDATE course. The Chinnar Wildlife Sanctuary is located in the Idukki district of Western Ghats of Kerala, India. The Sanctuary represents a large number of plants and animals unique to the thorny vegetation. It is one of the 18 wildlife sanctuaries among the protected areas of Kerala. It has earned the name for being the only rehabilitation centre for the Indian star tortoise in India. The team spent three days in and out of the jungle. They reached the destination in the evening and set out for an evening walk which led them to the watch tower. They spotted Chital deer, sambar, hanuman langur and peacocks along the road. Classes were covered on the topic of plastic recycling with the aim of equipping participants with a fundamental knowledge of how it is done. They also came across the pambar river which originates in the Anaimudi Hills in Idukki and the Madathala painted rocks. They were accompanied by three forest officers during their camp days. On the way back, they saw crocodiles resting in the Aliyar Dam. In a nutshell, students got a unique opportunity to create an understanding of the various elements of environment, the excitement of discovery and hand-on experiences and the joy of an interrelated world.



NATURE CAMP
