

In line with the 2025 global theme "**Land Restoration, Desertification, and Drought Resilience**", our college organized a meaningful event focusing on the **Green Campus** initiative aimed at promoting eco-conscious practices and biodiversity on campus. The event was conducted under the guidance of the Biodiversity Club, NSS Unit and the PG Department of Botany.
