

The NSS Unit 272 of CPA College of Global Studies, Puthanathani organized an **Anti-Ragging, Anti-Narcotics & Road Safety Awareness Program** on 25th August 2025 from 10:00 AM to 1:00 PM at the college seminar hall. The program was held in association with the Kerala Police, Motor Vehicle Department, and Excise Department and aimed at raising awareness among students about the legal, social, and personal consequences of ragging, narcotic use, and unsafe road practices.

The program was inaugurated by **Mr. Biju Parol**, Assistant Excise Inspector, who also delivered a powerful message on the importance of staying away from drugs and harmful substances. The welcome address was delivered by **Mr. Aboobacker K**, NSS Program Officer, who highlighted the role of NSS in promoting discipline, responsibility, and social awareness among students. The session was chaired by **Dr. John Joseph**, Principal of CPA College of Global Studies, who encouraged students to uphold the values of a safe and drug-free campus.

Three resource persons led the sessions:

Mr. Biju Parol, Assistant Excise Inspector, discussed the dangers of narcotic drugs, their long-term health effects, and the social and legal problems associated with addiction.
